

National Bull Riders, LLC
Event Producers Agreement

This agreement dated _____ between the National Bull Riders, LLC (NBR), South Carolina Limited Liability Companies and _____ (Producer).

Whereas Producer wishes and agrees to produce a professional bull riding sanctioned by the NBR and the NBR agrees to sanction the Bull Riding this agreement documents the terms of the NBR sanctioning and the rules the Producers agree to be bound by.

A. Producer agrees to the following:

1. Agrees to follow the payout schedule & rules listed in the NBR Rules and to be subject to the fines set in said rules or imposed by the NBR Board.
2. Producer's added money is funded by the either producer or sponsorships. It is added to the total money available to be paid out to the contestants according to the NBR payout schedule.
3. NBR contestant added money is to be paid in cash to the secretary before contestant payout.
4. The event will be sanctioned by the National Bull Riders bull riding association only and will not be co-sanctioned without NBR Board approval.
5. Producer will produce the event in accordance to the Competition Format in the NBR Rules.
6. Producer understands that they are responsible for providing sufficient and safe pens to house all of the NBR bulls as required by the stock contracts hired by the Producer. The flooring of the pens must be safe and harmless to the bulls' feet.
7. Producer agrees to provide the necessary back pen help to move the bulls during the event.
8. Producer agrees to provide the NBR contractors access to water.
9. Producer agrees to supply the venue for the bull riding and to buck the NBR bulls, including at least two (2) left hand delivery and two (2) right hand delivery bucking chutes. These chutes must be in good operating condition and safe for bucking the bulls.
10. Bucking chutes MUST have at least a 10 inch cat walk that is safely secured and in good condition.
11. The arena ground must be approved by an Event judge, a NBR representative, or stock contractor. The arena ground must be flat and not too deep. The bucking chutes must be filled with enough dirt to not foul the bull or risk chipping or cracking a hoof.
12. Producer understands that he is responsible for paying the two (2) NBR judges and they must be NBR approved judges. See Schedule A.
13. As the event producer the Producer is to provide and pay the announcer, bull fighters, bull rider secretary, back pen help, latch man, gate man and any other help needed to produce a bull riding. See Schedule A.
14. Producer will provide a qualified contestant secretary approved by the NBR. Producer assumes responsibility for collecting all fees and submitting all funds and paperwork to the NBR office. All funds must be paid to the NBR in accordance with the NBR Rules and NBR Payout Sheets.
15. Provide three standard sized and empty 55 gallon metal barrels and timers for the barrel racing, if Producer has barrel racing.
16. As the event producer, the Producer receives all of the gate and ticket money and does not share it with the NBR.
17. This agreement must be signed and received in the PBBA office before the event is listed on the PBBA or NBR schedule.
18. Producer agrees to have a certified and qualified EMT on sight during the entire performance.
19. Producer agrees to adhere to the rules of the NBR regarding dress code.

20. Producer agrees to adhere to the NBR rules regarding alcohol and drug use by event personnel and contestants during the performance. Alcohol consumption is not allowed from bull rider check-in time and until the event is over and the fans have left the arena.
21. Producer agrees to allow banner space, secondary to the Producer's event sponsors, for the NBR.

B. NBR agrees to the following:

1. Advertise the event in all NBR advertising and on the NBR websites.
2. To the best of the NBR ability help Producer get sufficient bull rider and barrel racer entries.
3. NBR paperwork needed by Producer's event secretary
4. Keep track of contestants' results and standing and publish same on NBR website.
5. Provide all year end NBR Finals awards to for NBR bull riders.

This agreement is binding on both parties and will be interpreted under the laws of South Carolina. By signing the event Producer agrees to the term and conditions of this agreement and confirms they have received and read a copy of the NBR Rules.
